WHAT YOUR MONEY DOES



What \$1 a week could do.

- Can provide registration and fees for a child to attend camp.
- Help purchase three booster seats for safe transportation for children.
- Can provide four counseling sessions for domestic violence victims.
- Can purchase caps and gloves during the winter for those who would do without.
- Provides one classroom of children with an educational puppet performance.
- Will purchase supplies to tutor 23 children through the Homework Help program.

What \$3 a week could do.

- Can provide a child the opportunity to take swimming lessons.
- Help provide materials for teaching basic reading, writing, computer, and math skills.
- Can provide a terminally ill patient care for one day.
- Can pay for recreational activities for those with significant disabilities.
- Provides 25 doses of influenza vaccines for patients who could not afford them.

What \$5 a week could do.

- Will provide meals for two months for homebound elderly.
- Will provide 4 full scholarships for youth to attend camp.
- Can provide 150 backpacks for needy students.

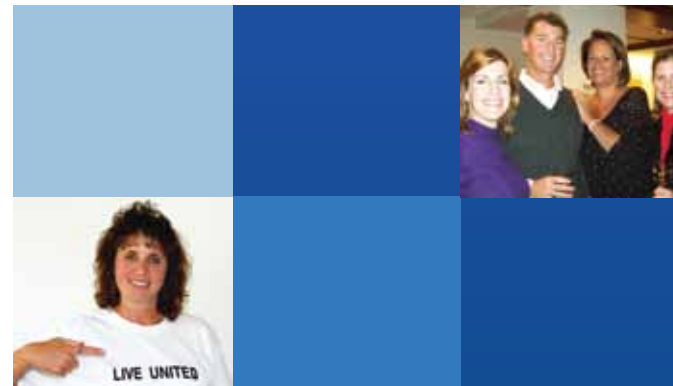
