Volunteers also learned about programs and services that are provided right here in Harrison County.

Some of the projects that were completed included landscaping at Health Access Medical Clinic and Sheltered Workshop; general weeding and sprucing up at the Hospice Garden; painting at Bi-County Nutrition and Central West Virginia Community Action; organizing supplies at the Harrison County Child Advocacy Center, Harrison County CASA and Literacy Volunteers. The YWCA's commercial kitchen received a thorough cleaning from top to bottom.

Nancy Stacy, HR Manager with the Brideport Target store and fellow Target employees used the opportunity as a team-building exercise. Employees from Dominion and Pratt & Whitney felt their community service projects were time well spent.
