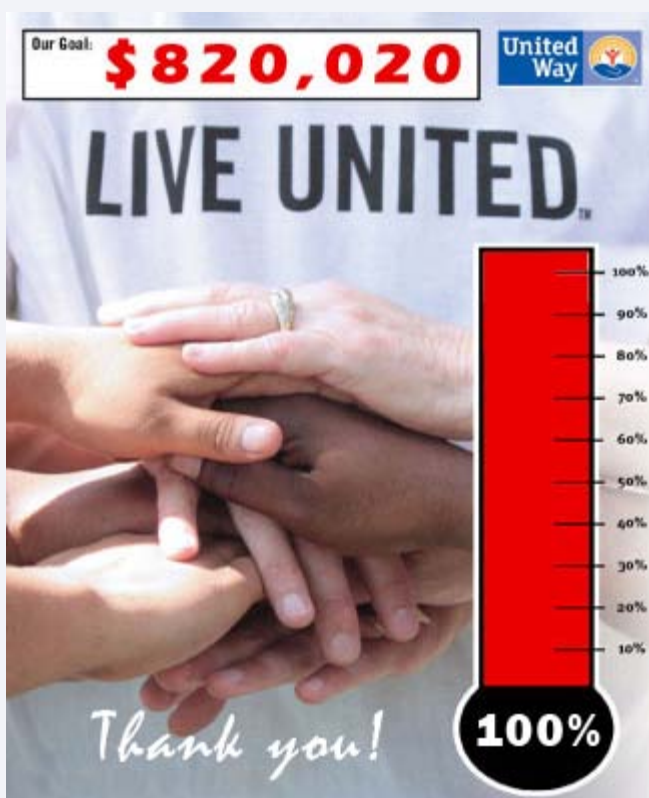

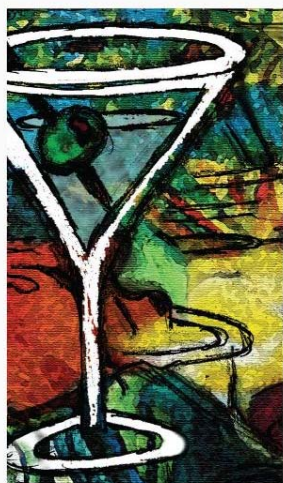

FamilyWize Prescription Cards and the 2011 Donut Hole

For anyone entering the Medicare "donut hole" in 2011, the FamilyWize Prescription Discount Card may help with the cost of **Generic Drugs** while in the coverage gap. If you enter the donut hole in July or later, you probably won't spend enough to exit the donut hole and qualify for new, lower rates through catastrophic coverage. In that case, the FamilyWize card can be a big help.

We will be asking for household information such as number of people living in house, address and total household income. This food is available to you whether or not you have received a food order from a food pantry or any other assistance.

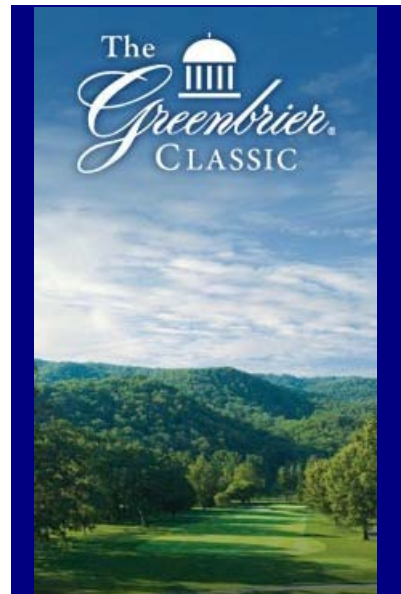

Earned income includes all taxable income gained from working. To qualify for the EITC, a person must work full or part-time and have earned income during the year. If married and filing jointly, at least one spouse must work and have earned income.
