United Way of Harrison County funds local non-profit organizations that meet critical needs every day. Twenty-four agencies provide services that literally cross the life-line of our community. Agencies wishing to receive funding must apply annually to be considered. Funding requests are reviewed by the United Way's Grants Committee. Over a six week period, the Grants Committee reviews agency applications, financial reports, audits and program information. Volunteers visit each applicant and report their findings to the Committee. The final funding recommendation is approved by the United Way's Board of Directors. United Way of Harrison County is participating in the Kroger Cares Program. You can support the United Way by purchasing and using the Kroger Cares Card. Your Kroger Cares Card, for an initial purchase of \$5, will start with an account balance of \$5 and can be used to purchase groceries and gasoline at any Kroger store.

The process is simple. Load money onto your card from time to time and then use your card each time you buy groceries at Kroger. The card you've been given can be used over and over again for an indefinite period of time.

The serial number on the gift card is linked to United Way's account with Kroger. Kroger gives us 5% of the total amount of funds reloaded onto all the cards linked to our account! Everyone needs groceries! What a great way to help the community, especially if you regularly shop at Kroger!

You can reload your card at the customer service desk at Kroger or you can ask a cashier to reload your card before your items are checked out. You may pay for the reload with cash, check, debit card, or credit card. The card functions just like cash and cannot be replaced if lost or stolen.

When paying for your groceries with your Kroger Cares Card, you can also use your Kroger Plus Card to get specials. Then simply use your card to pay for your groceries. There is no extra cost for you, but you'll have the satisfaction that you are helping to support UWHC every time you reload your card.
