



## Kroger Cares Program with United Way of Harrison County

United Way of Harrison County, UWHC, is now participating in the Kroger Cares Program. You can support the UWHC by purchasing and using the Kroger Cares Card. Your Kroger Cares Card, for an initial purchase of \$5, will start with an account balance of \$5 and can be used to purchase groceries at any Kroger store.

To support the UWHC on an ongoing basis, reloading money to your card from time to time and then use your card each time you buy groceries at Kroger. The card you've been given can be used over and over again for an indefinite period of time.

The serial number on the gift card is linked to the UWHC's account with Kroger. Kroger gives us 5% of the total amount of funds reloaded onto all the cards linked to our account! Everyone needs groceries! What a great way to help your community, especially if you regularly shop at Kroger!

You can reload your card at the customer service desk at Kroger or you can ask a cashier to reload your card before your items are checked out. You may pay for the reload with cash, check, debit card, or credit card. The card functions just like cash and cannot be replaced if lost or stolen.

When paying for your groceries with your Kroger Cares Card, you can also use your Kroger Plus Card to get Kroger specials. The Kroger Cares Card can be used to purchase virtually anything at any Kroger including purchases at Kroger gas stations.

Then simply use your card to pay for your groceries. There is no extra cost for you, but you'll have the satisfaction that you are helping to support UWHC every time you reload your card.
